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SECTION 1 - CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS, OFFICIALS & SPECTATORS

- (1) All persons attending matches controlled by the N.T.J.F.A. Competition do so with the permission & license of the competition & not otherwise.
- (2) Clubs are responsible for the conduct of their members, parents & the spectators who support them.
- (3) Clubs that do not exercise control over their members, parents of players or spectators may be called upon by the N.T.J.F.A. Board to accept responsibility for such behavior.
- (4) At the time of registration or some other time, prior to the first roster match of each season, officials, coaches, trainers & other persons are to be handed a copy of this code.
- (5) All such officials, coaches, trainers & other persons must agree to be bound by this code prior to acceptance of registration of them.
- (6) No person attending a match controlled by the N.T.J.F.A. competition shall;
 1. Use offensive or obscene language or gesture to any player, umpire, official or another spectator.
 2. Enter the field of play during the course of the match.
 3. Dispute the decision of an umpire or match manager.
 4. Assault or act with aggression to any other person.
 5. Behave in any way contrary to the spirit of the game.
 6. Behave in any way that disrupts the enjoyment of the match by any other person or brings discredit to the N.T.J.F.A. competition.
 7. Act in such a way as to exhibit racial intolerance by language or conduct to another person.
 8. Refuse to accept the reasonable direction of match manager or official of the N.T.J.F.A. competition or of the club, which that person is supporting.
- (7) Any person contravening Rule 6 (six) of this code may be identified & reported by the match manager.
 1. Upon making or receiving a report, the Match Manager must draw the attention of the offending person to this code.
 2. The match manager must note on the back of the match controller's sheet, the time of & nature of his/her report & inform the team manager.
 3. In the event that the offending person does not desist from the offending conduct, such person will be asked by the match manager to leave the ground immediately.
 4. The request to leave the ground & the time thereof must be noted by the match manager, on the back of the match controller's sheet.
 5. In the event that a person refuses to obey the direction of the match manager the match manager may direct the umpire to stop or terminate the match.
- (8) In the event that the match is so terminated, the fact will be reported to the board of the N.T.J.F.A. which may at its absolute discretion, against which there will be no appeal, award points for the match to the team other than that which the offender is supporting, or declare that neither side will receive any points for the match or impose fines or any other penalty so deemed by the board.
- (9) If the match manager cannot identify a particular person or persons who are contravening Rule 6 (six) he/she may report the behavior to the manager of the team concerned & to the board of the club which that person or persons are supporting.
- (10) Upon receiving a report from the match manager, the team manager must draw this code to the attention of the supporters of that team. The match manager must note on the report sheet, the time of & nature of his/her report to the team manager.
- (11) Where a team does not have a team manager at the ground, any request or direction made by a match manager to any official of that team's club shall be regarded as a direction to the team manager for the purpose of this code.
- (12) **PENALTIES FOR PARENTS, OFFICIALS & SPECTATORS**
Penalties for parents, officials & spectators shall be double the penalties applying to players for the same offence, or as the board deems fit to impose.

THIS CODE OF CONDUCT SHOULD BE READ BY ALL OFFICIALS. COPIES SHOULD BE MADE & GIVEN TO EACH PLAYER'S FAMILY WITH INSTRUCTIONS TO READ CAREFULLY. PREMIERSHIP POINTS MAY BE LOST &/OR CLUBS FINED DUE TO INDISCRETIONS BY OFFICIALS OR SPECTATORS FROM YOUR CLUB.

PARENTAL CONSENT
